#### LETTER OF ADVICE

#### **Dear Uncle**

Based on the information you provided in the questionnaire and during the consultation, we recommend you pursue the permanent residency in Australia via skilled migration program.

The visa options include:

- Skilled Work Regional (Provisional) (subclass 491) visa followed by Permanent Residence (Skilled Regional) visa (subclass 191)
- Skilled Nominated visa (subclass 190)
- Skilled Independent visa (subclass 189)

The process includes the following steps:

- 1. Selection of an occupation:
  - a. Analysis of the applicant's qualifications and professional experience and selection of the most suitable occupation for nomination from the skilled list.
  - b. Analysis of the requirements of the skills assessment authority and confirmation that the applicant has good chances for a positive skills assessment for the selected occupation.
  - c. Analysis of the previous invitation rounds for the selected occupation (minimum points required).
  - d. Analysis of the demand for the selected occupation in the states and territories.
  - e. Analysis of the requirements of the states/territories for the selected occupation for 491 and 190 visa applicants.

#### Conclusion

<u>Subclass 189 visa:</u> Minimum required points is 65. You have 75 points but in the previous invitation rounds only those who scored 95-100 points were invited to apply. We don't recommend choosing this highly competitive visa.

<u>Subclass 190 and 491 visas:</u> Minimum required points is 65. You have 80 and 90 points respectively. We recommend choosing a subclass 491 visa for higher chances to be invited. We recommend choosing Western Australia where there is still shortage of accountants. For a subclass 190 visa, WA has a requirement to have a job offer in place before you apply. If you don't have a job offer, you can only apply for a subclass 491 visa.

We recommend you complete your course of study and apply for a postgraduate visa (subclass 485). You will be able to stay in Australia for 2-3 more years with full working rights. This will give you additional time to improve your points. This will also be an opportunity to find an employer who will be able to sponsor you or make you eligible for a subclass 190 visa sponsored by WA.
